- Japanese experience in Morocco -

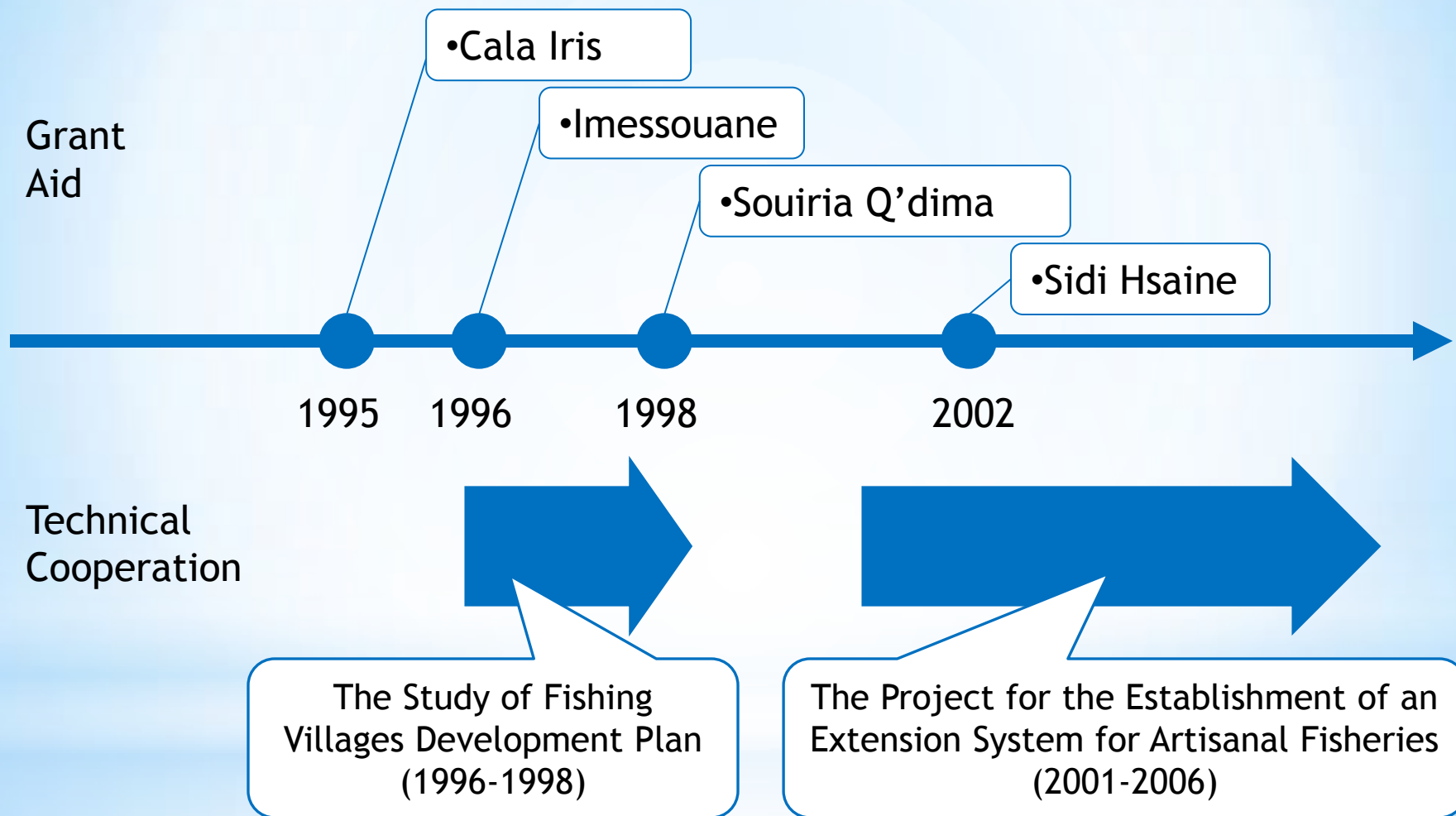


Since 1979, Japan has supported the development of Moroccan Fisheries Sector.



As of 2016, Morocco is the country that has received the most Grant Aid in the fisheries sector from Japan with about 16 billion JPY.

In 1995, Japan has begun its intervention in the development of Artisanal Fisheries in the Kingdom of Morocco.



Japan has financed the construction of 4 fishing villages.

From 1996 to 1998, Japan has supported the elaboration of “Fishing Villages Development Plan” in Morocco.

Problems in the Field

- ✓ Uneven distribution of fisheries resources
- ✓ Inefficient fishing technologies / techniques
- ✓ Necessity for sustainable development
- ✓ Lack of fisheries infrastructures
- ✓ Establishment of distribution network
- ✓ Insufficient organization of fishermen
- ✓ Fragile economic base of fishermen
- ✓ Difficulty of law enforcement

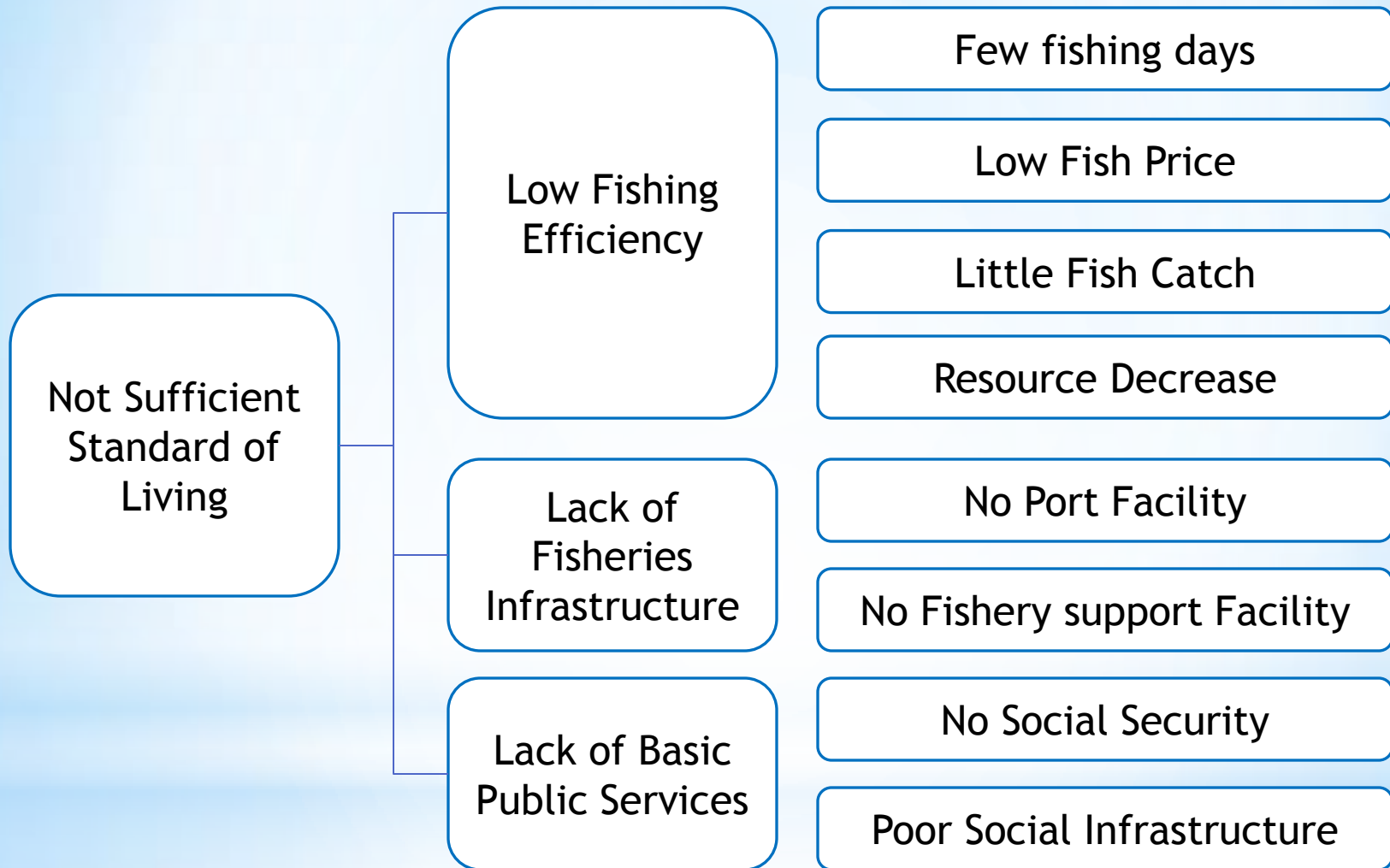

The plan has become the foundation for the construction of PDAs in Morocco .

As the result of the plan, 120 artisanal fisheries villages were classified taking into account the potential for development.

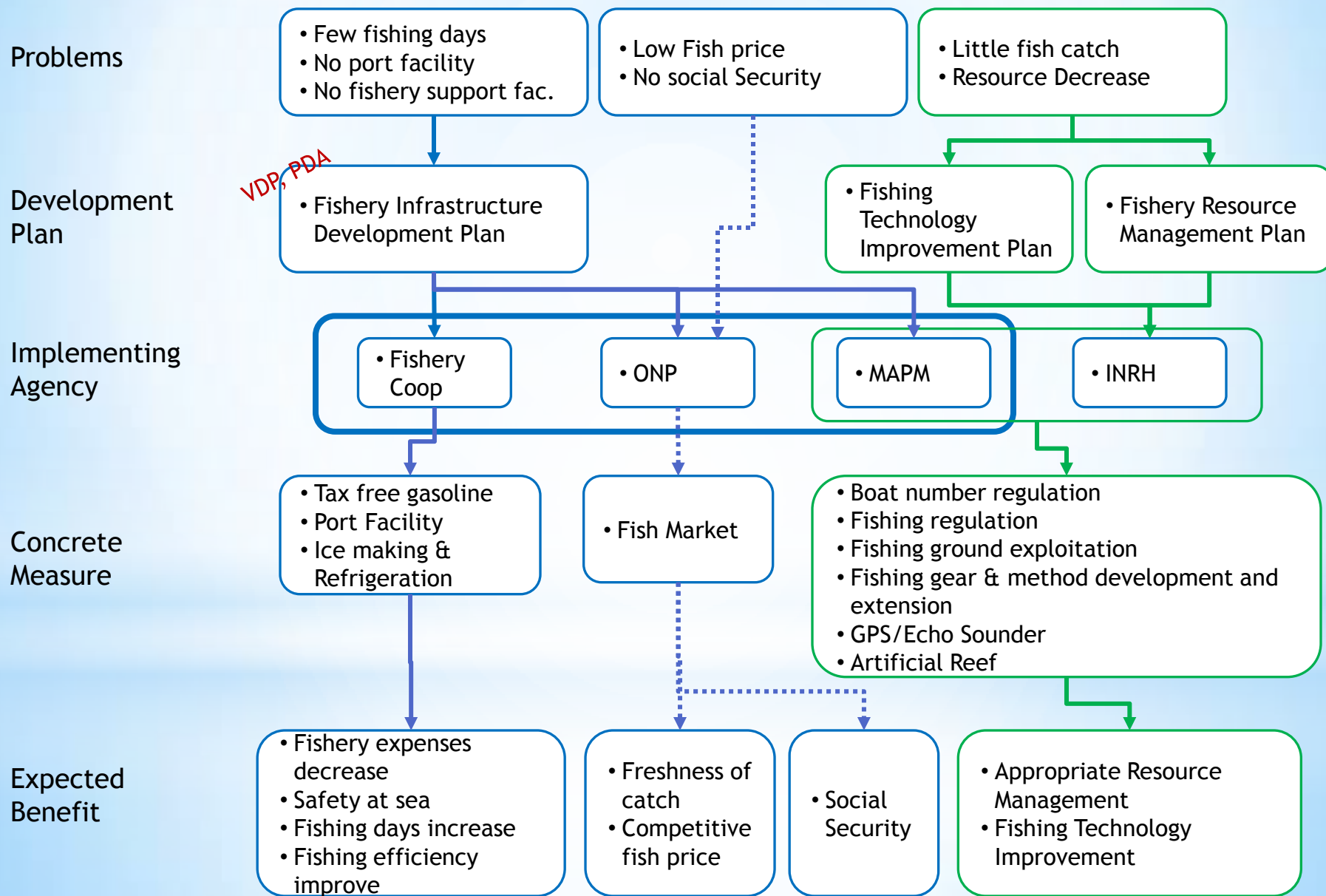

B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fishing Port with 50-100 boats • Medium production • Fishing is restricted to certain seasons 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approx. 20 Villages • Slipway for fishing boats • Medium scale ground facilities • Phased development approach
C	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fishing Port with less than 50 boats • Fishing is seasonal • Dependence to fisheries is low 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approx. 70 Villages • Fishing gear storage, access road

These issues are commonly found in other developing countries as well.

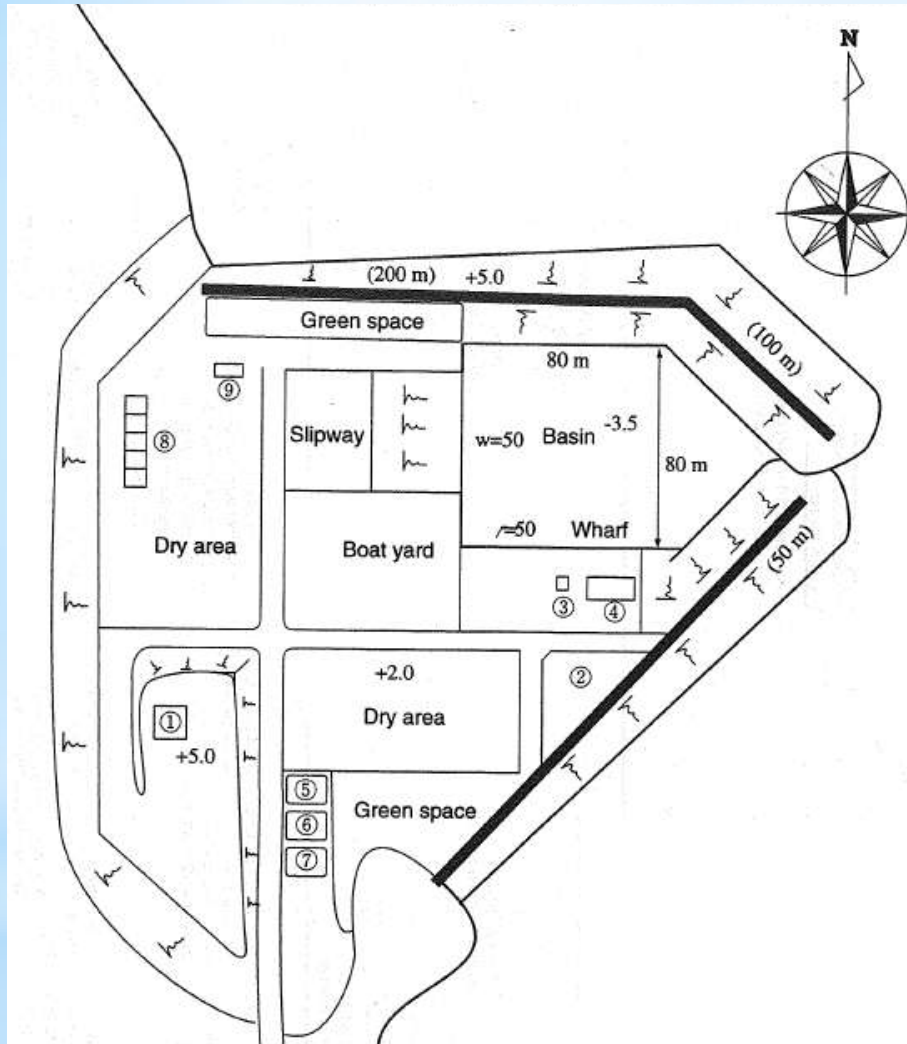
Basic concept behind development of artisanal fisheries are as follows;
